The Friends of the Greenburgh Library is a voluntary, nonprofit group of library supporters who believe in the importance of the Greenburgh Library as a social and intellectual center of our community -- and in a larger sense, as one of the key foundations of American democracy.

Donations to the Friends support a wide variety of programs and services that are run by the Board of the Friends of the Greenburgh Library and that are available to the community at no charge.

What do the Friends do?

- ORGANIZES and runs major book sales
- SUPPORTS staff enrichment and recognition
- FUNDS major equipment purchases
- PROVIDES scholarships through the Library's Page Scholarship Program, which rewards senior pages with a stipend when they graduate from high school
- FUNDS and supports programming for adults, teens, and children
- UNDERWRITES hospitality at special meetings and events

What are some of the Friends of the Greenburgh Library's accomplishments?

- Purchased for the library \$35,000 worth of much-needed colorful and fun furniture for the Children's Room in the newly expanded library
- Also purchased for the library such equipment as:
- Multimedia projector
- Video drop
- Die cut machine for children's craft programs
- Funded moving, and the continuous tuning of, the Greenburgh Library's new concert-quality piano
- Funded various programs for children, teens, and adults
- Funded refreshments for many Library programs, including children, teen, and adult programming
- Ran the successful 2009 Friends of the Greenburgh Library book sale to raise funds; currently working on the 2010 book sale, October 1-5
